Homes and families should be places of harmony and understanding. Sometimes

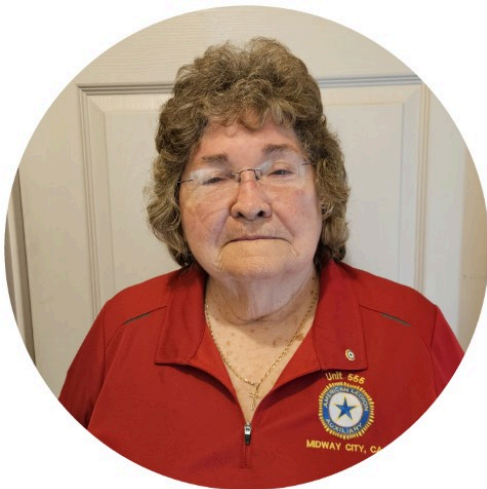
our veterans and uphold the values of the American Legion. I am committed to working tirelessly to support our mission, promote patriotism, and advocate for the well-being of our veterans and their families.




